Adapted primary school – information to guardians.

When you apply for your child to attend an adapted primary school, you have the right to an interpreter in all contacts with the municipality. You will also receive help and support in making the application from both the preschool/school and the municipality's coordinator. The coordinator will, if your wish, meet with you in person to inform and assist.

If your child has an intellectual disability or a brain injury, your child can be placed in an “anpassad grundskola”, an adapted school. In Värmdö municipality there is “Kullsvedsskolan”.

Children can attend from grades 1-9 at Kullsvedsskolan and at the upper secondary school. There is no preschool class (for children who are 6 years old) at Kullsvedsskolan.

You will receive help from the preschool or school in gathering all the documents needed and in making an application.

The municipality needs to check if your child has the right to go to an adapted school before your child can get a place. In order to be accepted, a social investigation, an educational investigation, a medical investigation and a psychological investigation are needed.

It is the principal of the preschool or school where the child attends who is responsible for starting an investigation into whether a child belongs to the adapted school's target group or not. When the investigation is complete, guardians apply for admission to an adapted school. It is the pre-school or the school that collects the investigations that are needed and then sends them collected to the municipality's reception team. The headmaster and the guardians also sign a document in which they approve that the municipality examines whether the child should be accepted into an adapted school..

Questions and answers about adapted elementary school.

Who will approve the application?

If both parents are guardians, both must always sign all documents.

We are moving to Värmdö, what do we do then?

If you are moving to Värmdö, you can get a place in an adapted primary school at any time during the year. If you are not yet registered in Värmdö municipality, you need to send proof that you will move here. It could be, for example, a rental agreement or a housing contract.

When will I find out if my child belongs to the target group for adapted primary school?

The municipality's team regarding adapted primary school meet once a month to makes decisions about receptions. As soon as a decision is made, the coordinator of the team will contact the guardians and inform them of the decision. The coordinator offers a meeting with the parents, together with an interpreter if necessary, to be able to inform about what it means to attend an adapted primary school.

How do I apply for after-school care?

If you work or study, your child is entitled to a place in after-school care. As soon as your child gets a place at Kullsvedskolan, you can apply for a place in a leisure center via the link on Kullsvedskolan's website.
